On Tuesday, January 26, Tillicum Elementary participated in a Traffic Safety Walkabout as a part of Tillicum's School Travel Planning efforts (part of the Active & Safe Routes to School program). The aim of this program is to help reduce school traffic congestion and encourage more students to walk, scooter or cycle on their journey to and from school.

This walkabout was an opportunity for the Tillicum school community and municipal representatives to walk around the Tillicum neighbourhood together to actively explore some of the community's concerns regarding safe walking and cycling at Tillicum and to brainstorm potential solutions to the traffic safety challenges.

Representatives from the District of Saanich, the Greater Victoria School District, the Ministry of Transportation, Island Health, School Liaison Constable Dani Froloff, and cycling advocates met with Principal Lori Burley and a group of parents from the Tillicum school community.

The group walked around the Tillicum neighbourhood to explore particular areas of concern and challenges to safe walking and cycling to school, as identified by the School Travel Planning Take Home Survey in October. Key areas of concern included the Tillicum & Burnside intersection, the Orillia & Maddock crossing, and traffic congestion around the school.

For Middle and Secondary Schools, please note this change in process:


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Tillicum School is 100 years old!
