Principal's Message

Winter has definitely arrived! Colds and flu are affecting many of our students and staff. Please talk with your children about the importance of hand washing, good nutrition and plenty of rest to help minimize illness. Children enjoy the opportunity to play outdoors and there are learning benefits from fresh air and exercise, so it is also very important at this time of year to ensure that your child is dressed appropriately to enjoy outdoor activities comfortably.

As you probably already know, we have recently switched to electronic distribution of our newsletter. As a means for us to verify that people are receiving and reading their emailed newsletters we are offering a little incentive. For the next three months, a question will be posed somewhere in the newsletter for a specific group. The first parent/guardian to call into the office with the answer to the question will win a prize! (The answer will be found in the newsletter.) *This week's question is for the families of grade 3 students:* "On which days are the Tillicum Craft Market taking place?" The prize is a grocery card. If you know the answer and are the parent/guardian of a grade 3 student, call 250-386-1408.

Our Seaton and Burnside crossing guard has been away and will return on November 28th. There is no replacement available in her absence. Please remind children to use extra care when crossing at this busy intersection!

Families are reminded that supervision on the playground begins at 8:30 each morning and ends at 3:00 each afternoon. Please arrange for your child's arrival at school no earlier than 8:30 am and pick up no later than 3 pm. We also ask drivers to please obey the law by **not** parking or stopping in the bus zone and observing drop off/pick up times: 10 minutes maximum, Mon-Fri from 8-9 am and 2-4 pm. These times are in effect on Albina from Maddock to the staff parking lot, and on Orillia from Burnside to the bus zone. Darker, wetter conditions make visibility difficult, especially after school, so it is important to reduce traffic congestion in front of the bus zones to ensure student safety.

Report cards will be going home on December 1st. Please take time to read over your child's progress report carefully and discuss the results with your child. We have much to celebrate and some very important learning goals for all our students for next term. In the coming weeks, we have much to look forward to. I'd like to thank students, staff and parents for their hard work and support in all aspects of life at Tillicum
