November is here! Everyone is working hard at *Tillicum* and we are not far from Winter Break. Students have been actively engaged in their academic programs. Teachers and support staff are doing what they do best at *Tillicum* – providing a safe, caring, and engaging learning environment for our students to succeed. November brings shorter days, rain, wind and cooler temperatures. Students will continue to enjoy outdoor recess and lunchtime play opportunities. Please ensure that your child has a warm, waterproof jacket and boots, as we will continue to go outside for recess and lunch recess.

This time of year also raises concerns over the transmission of flu and colds. Frequent hand washing, and teaching of proper coughing and sneezing practices continue to be emphasized at *Tillicum*. Thank you for your support by keeping your child home if they are sick where they can rest and recover most quickly. We also appreciate the many phone calls and emails from parents informing us of their child's absence. It is not only an important part of student safety; it is also helpful to us in managing the spread of illness in the school.

As darkness falls earlier with each day, it is important that students are aware of safe routes home and that all drivers exercise extreme caution in our student drop off and pick up zones. PLEASE do not drop your child off in the middle of the street. The staff parking lot and fire lanes are *NOT* for student drop off or pick up. Parents are reminded to use the designated areas for drop-off and pick-up. Please plan accordingly and park and walk to school with your child as necessary. We thank you for continuing to support our safe drop off and pick up routines.

We continue to have our Home Reading "Thermometer" in the main hallway. Your support with daily home reading is appreciated and goes a long way in promoting the life-long skill of reading with our students. Collectively, students at *Tillicum* have completed over 2000 nights of home reading. We all look forward to celebrating our goal for this term of 5000 nights of home reading! To celebrate, our students have decided they would like an extra recess! Thank you for helping us reach our goal!



Citizenship at Tillicum

We are excited to now offer an online payment option for the Nutritional Snack Program! If you have already registered your child with School CashOnline you will see it as a new payment option before the start of each month.


