Safety at Tillicum



Another one of our priorities at *Tillicum* is the safety of all the students and staff while in and around the building. To that end, we regularly practice fire drills, ensuring the entire school population is able to exit the building quickly and quietly. On Tuesday, October 8th, *Tillicum* will have the Saanich Fire Department here to assist us with a fire drill. We will also be taking part in the BC Provincial Earthquake ShakeOut Earthquake drill. The earthquake drill will be on Thursday, October 17th and will be an opportunity to review and practice our earthquake emergency plans. We hope that

students and families have discussed earthquake preparedness for their homes. On

<u>Tuesday</u>, <u>November 19th we will be having a lockdown DRILL organized by Saanich Police</u>. Schools practice lockdown drills in order to prepare for the unlikely event that we would have to go into lockdown due to a potential threat to our safety. We keep these drills low key, but wanted to share with parents that this practice drill is part of our safety plans at *Tillicum*.

Another aspect of SAFETY for us is bicycle safety and parking lot safety. We have stressed the importance of bicycle safety with students – choosing SAFE riding routes to and from school, *wearing a helmet*, etc. We have also reminded students that all of the bicycles in our bike racks during the school day should be locked, and are out of bounds to all students. Regarding student drop off on Orillia Street, we wish to remind parents to stay clear of the bus zone and residential driveways. Pick up and drop off on Albina Street is also very busy (parents are reminded to please not park in the Staff Parking lot as it is reserved for staff), and we want to remind everyone that SAFETY is of huge importance – please do your part to be safe!

Dressing for the Weather

The wet, sometimes windy, west coast winter weather will soon be here. It is therefore important that students are dressed appropriately for these conditions. We would appreciate your support in ensuring that your child arrives at school on rainy days with



warm, water-resistant/waterproof clothing: a jacket/poncho (preferably with a hood) and closed shoes (rain boots, if possible.) Unless it is **raining heavily**, our students do go out for recess, exercise activities, or neighbourhood walks. Some field trips also involve students being outdoors, even when the weather is wet. Proper clothing will help keep your child warm and dry throughout the day.

Music

We are very excited to see that Senior Choir is up and running. Senior Choir is open to all students in Grade 3,4 and 5. Practices are every **Tuesday @ Lunch Recess**. No experience is necessary, so come out and sing with us! We are looking forward to our next performance at the Remembrance Day assembly. A big thank you to all of the staff stepping up to provide this opportunity for our students.

Athletics and Healthy Living at Tillicum

Athletics and healthy living are important for everyone, particularly for elementary school students! We are committed to providing opportunities for kids to be involved at our school athletically and we promote healthy living. Thanks to **Ms. Nadeau** for coaching our *Disc Golf team* this year and a big thank you to **Mr. Carlson** for coaching our Cross-Country team this year! The students at *Tillicum* have also been encouraged to be part



of our *soccer program*, which is always a HUGE success. Thank you to **Mrs. Easton** for coaching soccer this year! Our annual soccer jamboree is scheduled for October 30th.

Spirit Day - Orange and Black Day

On October 31st, we will be having our annual Orange and Black Day. In the past, we have asked students to leave their costumes at home. This year students will be able to come to school in a costume provided they are still able to use the stairs and washroom independently. Please be mindful that costumes may be damaged during the day and that all costumes must be appropriate for school (no masks/weapons). We believe this will be extremely successful in allowing students the opportunity to dress up a little and have some fun on Halloween. We encourage those not dressing up to wear black and/or orange clothing.
