   Lori and Megan will hopefully give supplies to them on Friday so they can be worked on over the weekend and sent to teachers Monday morning.
- <u>Sun-Oka Fruit Farm Apple Fundraiser</u> Megan Thomas will be coordinating. Oct 21<sup>st</sup> will be the delivery day and pick up will be Oct 22<sup>nd</sup>.
- <u>No Sort Bottle Drive #1</u> Lauralee Wood will be coordinating. Date TBD, possibly postponed because of ongoing construction.
- <u>Food for Fun</u> Lisa will be coordinating. First FFF will be October 17<sup>th</sup>. Future dates were confirmed as December 5th, January 30th, March 6th, April 24th and June 5th.
