Remembrance Day assembly was an excellent, beautiful production. The kids were phenomenal and very respectful. The senior choir was amazing, presentations hit all the right marks, and it was overall very inspiring.

FFF feedback- the staff wants to first thank the PAC for all their hard work, (an extra slice of pizza fixes all problems). The delivery timing during the eating break is problematic (supervision free lunch hours) as teachers usually leave at this time. Asking that all the pizza is at the classes by 11:40 with the younger grades being served first. More parent helpers to dole out the pizza would be welcome. Some orders are too large for some kids (they ask that parents order what is reasonable as for what can be eaten for a lunch).

Accessible playground follow up- There are 5 schools with accessible playgrounds in the district right now. A very rough pricing to adapt a playground is \$200,000. The feedback received is that going cheaper doesn't pay off in the end—the goal is not just for kids to be able to get to the playground but to actually be able to play there. Check out Oak Bay's Public Playground (as an example of an excellent accessible playground)
